

Memorandum of Agreement

Between
The Teaching Support Staff Union

And
Simon Fraser University

Upon ratification and the approval of the May 1, 2010 to April 30, 2014 Collective Agreement currently being negotiated, the parties agree to establish a joint working committee. This committee shall be composed of at least three representatives from each of the University and the TSSU. SFU commits to include at least one faculty member who has taught a course or tutorial at Simon Fraser University in the last three years.

This Committee will meet at least once per month until the commencement of the next round of bargaining. The purpose of the Committee will be to continue the discussion on the issues that were raised by the parties during the negotiations, but were left unresolved. This Committee will produce a joint report to the next round of bargaining. The parties also agree solutions that address items and issues raised in this Committee may be implemented by mutual agreement prior to the next round of bargaining.


The issues identified during negotiations shall include, but are not limited to:

- Article VI – Union Facilities
- Article XI – Arbitration / Troubleshooter
- Article XIII - TAs
- Article XIII - TAs Priority System
- Article XIV – Sessionals
- Article XIV – Sessional Reappointment System
- Article XV – TMs
- Article XVII – Conditional Upon enrolment
- L portion of the Collective Agreement – ELC / ITP
