The duties of the TSSU Officers are enumerated in **By-Law E.2**. The description of the Chief Steward-Organizer position is reproduced below, with individual descriptions of the Chief Steward and Organizer positions outlined in By-Laws E.2.7 and E.2.9:

Chief Steward-Organizer is an amalgamated position continuing in the Spring 2024 election cycle that replace the Chief Steward II and Organizer I positions and encompass their duties as outlined in By-Laws E.2.7 and E.2.9. Thus, the elected officer who holds this position will be responsible for 25 hours of work per week and the division of these hours will depend on necessary tasks determined jointly by the Chief Steward I, Organizer II, and Chief Steward-Organizer.
